

Welcoming a new GP practice to our building – changes at 28 Laycock Street

What is happening?

As of 1 September 2018, Islington Central Medical Centre will be sharing its building at 28 Laycock Street N1 1SW with Roman Way Medical Centre.

Both practices will operate from the same building but under their own names.



Why is this happening?

After 28 years of serving the local community, one of the GP Partners at Roman Way Medical Centre, Dr Bina Shah, will retire this August 2018. With Dr Shah's retirement, on 31 August, the Roman Way Medical Centre premises will no longer be available and the practice needed a new site to move to.

The GPs at both Roman Way Medical Centre and Islington Central Medical Centre agreed that it would be in the best interest for patients if the two practices worked more closely together from the premises at Laycock Street.

I am a patient of Islington Central Medical Centre – what does this mean for me?

- As of 1 September 2018, Roman Way Medical Centre will operate from the same building as Islington Central Medical Centre. This arrangement should not disrupt your care in any way. You will still be able to see your GP as normal and receive advice or treatment when needed.
- You do not need to do anything. You will remain registered at Islington Central Medical Centre, will be able to see a GP as before and telephone numbers will not change.



What happens next?

The patients and staff of Roman Way Medical Centre will move to 28 Laycock Street, N1 1SW on 1 September 2018.

In the coming weeks and months you may notice some changes in the building as Dr Hai and Dr Rodrigues begin work to welcome and accommodate patients and staff.

We understand that you might be worried about these changes and we will be working closely with our colleagues from Roman Way Medical Centre during the transition period to ensure it goes as smoothly as possible for everyone.

This arrangement should not disrupt your care in any way.
